

Jatiya Party's politics was not right: GM Quader

Online Desk: Jatiya Party (JaPa)'s politics was not right from the very beginning, said the party's chairman GM Quader. He made the remark while speaking at a meeting at the Chairman's Office at Banani in the capital on Tuesday (August 1). GM Quader said, "People consider Awami League and BNP sides of the coin. People want alternatives. But, we could not become alternative because our politics was not right."

The JaPa chairman said, "BNP wanted to do much harms to us, and we succeeded to foil it. But, Awami League wanted to split JaPa entering inside our party. They are still trying to split us. They want to control us. Because of it, people consider JaPa as a domesticated party of Awami League. On the other hand, Awami League thinks that it can sacrifice us."

Regarding the upcoming 12th general election, JaPa chairman said, "Our party will decide whether we would go for selection in the name of election. I am just expressing my feelings.
