

People's Engineering Day tomorrow

Online Desk: The 53rd founding anniversary of Institution of Diploma Engineers Bangladesh (IDEB) and the People's Engineering Day-2023 will be celebrated tomorrow.

This year's theme of the day is 'Unnoyoner Jonno Udvabon O Uddokta Niti'.
