

BNP flees from politics getting red card: Quader

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Online Desk: Awami League (AL) General Secretary Obaidul Quader today said BNP has fled from the field of politics after receiving red card due to its foul politics.

“Where is the BNP? There are 1,896 candidates in the election and we are ready to compete. But they (BNP) have fled away as its one-point movement fell in the ditch of Paltan,” he told an election rally of AL at Bangabandhu Udyan in Barishal city this afternoon.

AL President and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina spoke at the rally as the chief guest.

Quader said there is no leader except AL President Sheikh Hasina in Bangladesh who has the courage to acknowledge his or her past mistakes and vows to correct those.
