

Dense fog disrupts flight operations at Dhaka airport; 13 flights diverted

Online Desk: Flight operations at Hazrat Shahjalal International Airport (HSIA) were disrupted for seven and a half hours today due to dense fog.

Thirteen flights that failed to land at Dhaka airport were diverted to Kolkata, Hyderabad, Sylhet, and Chattogram international airports, Executive Director of HSIA, Group Captain Mohammad Kamrul Islam, told UNB.

He said flights could not operate normally from 2 am to 9:40 am today due to fog, adding that flight operations resumed at 9:40 am after visibility improved.
