

PM condemns terrorist attack in Moscow

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Online Desk: Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina has strongly condemned the terrorist attack that took place at the Crocus City Hall in Moscow killing over 130 people.

In a letter sent to Russian President Vladimir Putin, the Bangladesh Premier strongly condemned the cowardly and senseless terrorist attack which occurred at the Crocus City Hall in Moscow on 22 March, 2024.

“I am greatly shocked and resentful at the loss of so many innocent lives,” she said, adding, “I would like to offer my prayers for the salvation of the departed souls of the victims and extend my heartfelt condolences to their families.”
