

Bangladesh reports 22 more COVID-19 cases in 24hrs

Online Desk: Bangladesh reported 22 more COVID-19 cases in 24 hours till Friday morning.

With the new numbers, the country's total COVID-19 caseload rose to 2,050,134, according to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS).

The official death toll from the disease remained unchanged at 29,494 as no new fatalities were reported during this period.

The daily case test positivity rate was 3.69 percent as 271 samples were tested, said the DGHS.

The recovery and death rates stood at 98.41 percent and 1.44 per cent, respectively.
