

9,974 post offices converted into e-post centres: Palak

Online Desk: State Minister for Post, Telecommunication and Information Technology Zunaid Ahmed Palak today said the government has converted post offices into e-post centres aiming to make profit-oriented services institutions.

“As part of massive campaign for making all post offices profitable ones, the government has restructured with ICT (information and communications technology)-based services,” he told the inaugural function of the GI Products Fair at the Singra upazila parishad auditorium in the district.
