

# 5 lakh jobs to be created in govt sector in two years : Adviser Asif

**Online Desk :** A total of 5,00,000 jobs will be created in the government sector over the next two years, announced Asif Mahmud Sojib Bhuiyan, adviser to the Ministry of Youth and Sports and the Ministry of Labour and Employment, on Friday.
