

Police obstruct ‘March to Indian High Commission’

When the protesters started their march towards the Indian High Commission at around 3:30 pm on Wednesday, the police stopped them by setting up barricades at Uttar Badda on the way.

They came from different areas of Dhaka carrying banners and placards and joined the protest. Traffic movement was disrupted as the protesters took up positions on the road.
