

Sylhet airport to be transformed into full-fledged int'l airport : Jamaat Ameer

Online Desk : Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami Ameer Dr. Shafiqur Rahman has said that if his party comes to power, Sylhet's Osmani International Airport will be transformed into a truly full-fledged international airport. Addressing a rally at Kulaura in Moulvibazar on Saturday, he said, "When the world is moving forward rapidly, we are falling behind. To bring the country out of this situation, visionary and honest leadership is needed."

He added, regular international flights to major global destinations, including Manchester, will be launched and will not be allowed to be shut down under any circumstances.
