

Country's future dev depends on youth : Fakhrul

Online Desk : BNP Secretary General Mirza Fakhrul Islam Alamgir believes that the future development of Bangladesh depends largely on its youth. He made this remark while speaking to journalists on Saturday after paying tribute at the graves of former President Ziaur Rahman and former Prime Minister Khaleda Zia at Zia Udyan in the capital. Mirza Fakhrul said that Prime Minister and BNP Chairman Tarique Rahman has approved the full committee of Jubo Dal.
