

# Bangladesh, Pakistan discuss enhancing military cooperation

**Online Desk** : Pakistan High Commissioner to Bangladesh Imran Haider paid a courtesy call on Brigadier General (Retd) Dr AKM Shamsul Islam, Defence Adviser to the Prime Minister. During the meeting, they discussed ways to enhance military cooperation between the two countries.

The meeting took place on Sunday (June 28) at the office of the Defence Adviser at the Armed Forces Division in Dhaka Cantonment. A three-member delegation from the Pakistan High Commission also attended the meeting.
