

9 thousand poor people of Gopalganj's Kotalipara received Eid gifts from Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina

He said, so far we have given Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's Eid gifts sarees, lungi, Punjabi and food items to 9 thousand poor people as a party. Besides, Eid gifts are being distributed among the poor people by the government. Former Senior Secretary Md. Shahid Ulla Khandkar, representative in charge of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina's constituency development program, said that Sarees, Lungi, Punjabi and food items are being distributed to the poor people as Eid gifts of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina not only in Kotalipara but all over Bangladesh.
